

Message from the president of BEIS

Bangladesh Electronics Society (BES) was established in 1974 with earnest effort of some veteran professors and researchers of Dhaka University, Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET), Rajshahi University and Bangladesh Atomic Energy Commission (BAEC). Later it was renamed as Bangladesh Electronics and Informatics Society (BEIS) in 1989 to keep pace with rapid advances in various fields of electronics and information technology.

BEIS is a nonprofit organization in Bangladesh. Another aim of BEIS is to attract young people to research and to create a research environment where young researchers can be active.

BEIS from time to time organizes joint programs locally to promote colloquiums/dialogues in the field of education and research among different research organizations and universities devoted to science, engineering, and technology through the creation and dissemination of knowledge.
